Fee Structure For Sound Recordings:

Patrons are not provided DVDs or digital files of sound recordings. If off-site access is required CCHP staff will provide a link to the requested material. The link will be active for seven days.

Off-site research & personal use

\$1.00 per minute, with a maximum charge of \$40.00 per title, access limited to 7 days

<u>Digital Photography</u>: Permission must be obtained by CCHP staff before any archival materials are photographed. Photographed material is for research and personal use only and cannot be published or otherwise reproduced without written permission from the CCHP. Flash photography is prohibited.
