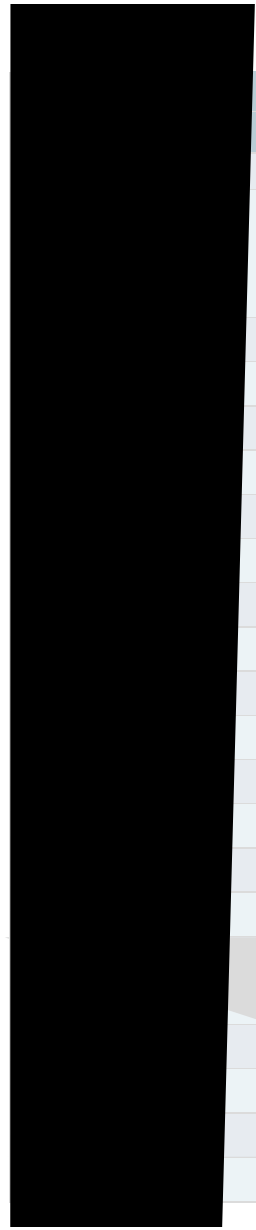


Part C - Screening Question
