

## Strengthen your credentials and improve your skills in meeting the needs of English learners.

Through a grant from the U.S. Department of Education, The University of Akron is offering graduate-level TESOL Endorsement coursework for teachers who work with English language learners.

The Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages (TESOL) Endorsement is a 19 credit hour program that will be offered to selected teachers over a one-year period.

Summer - 8 credits; Fall - 6 credits; Spring - 5 credits.

Teachers will have the option of attending classes in Akron or Lakewood.

### Eligibility Requirements

All applicants must be employed as a licensed teacher or administrator by one of the participating school districts.

Preference will be given to early childhood/elementary teachers.
