| Fire  | Immediately stop what you are doing.<br>Pull closest fire alarm pull station.<br>Exit the area using closest exit. | Medical Emergency   | Provide the following information to the dispatcher: your name, type of emergency, location of the victim(s), condition of the victim(s), any dangerous conditions.
