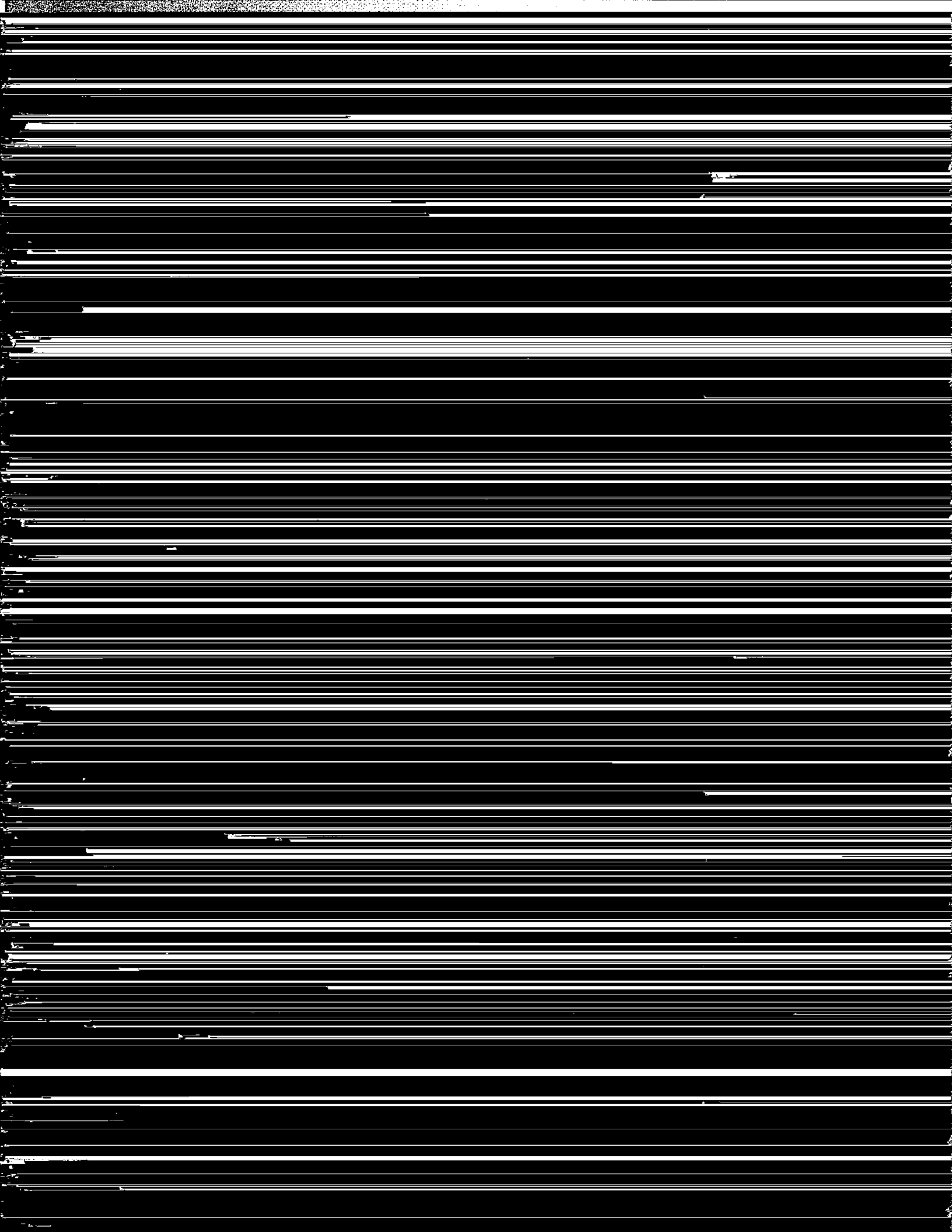


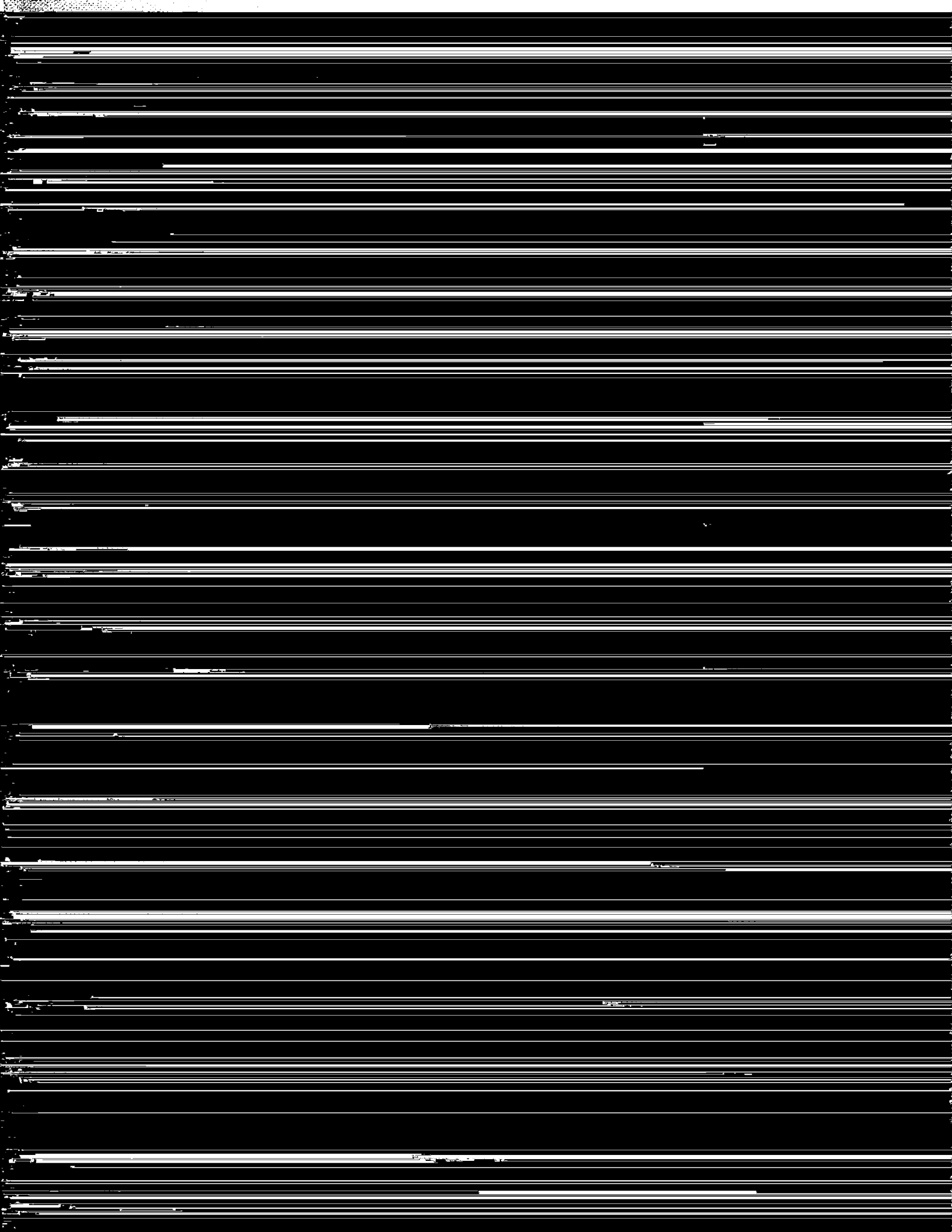
This study is exploratory in nature, so that respondents were asked about their definitions of domestic violence and abuse. Thus, the interviewer did not impose definitions on



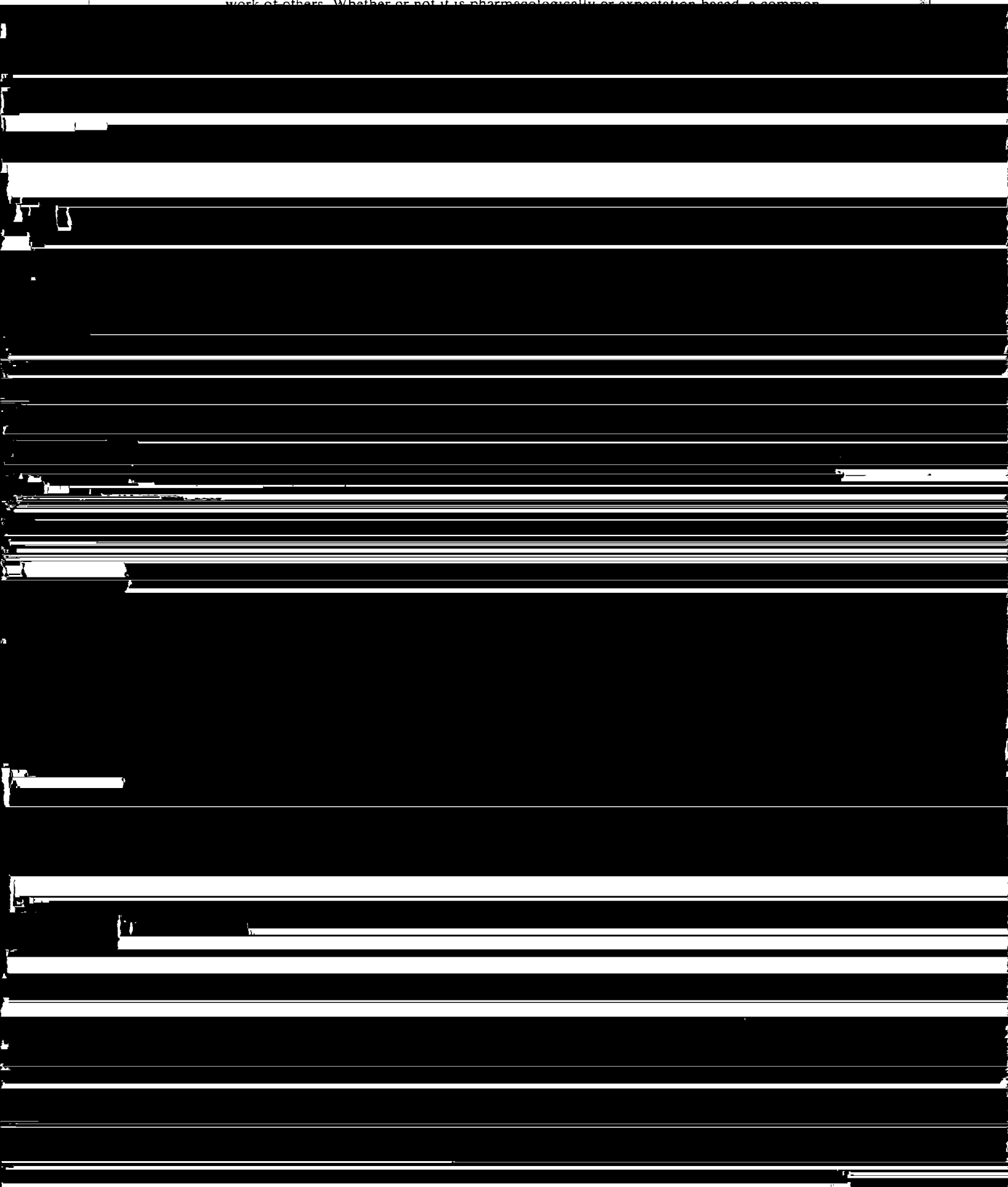

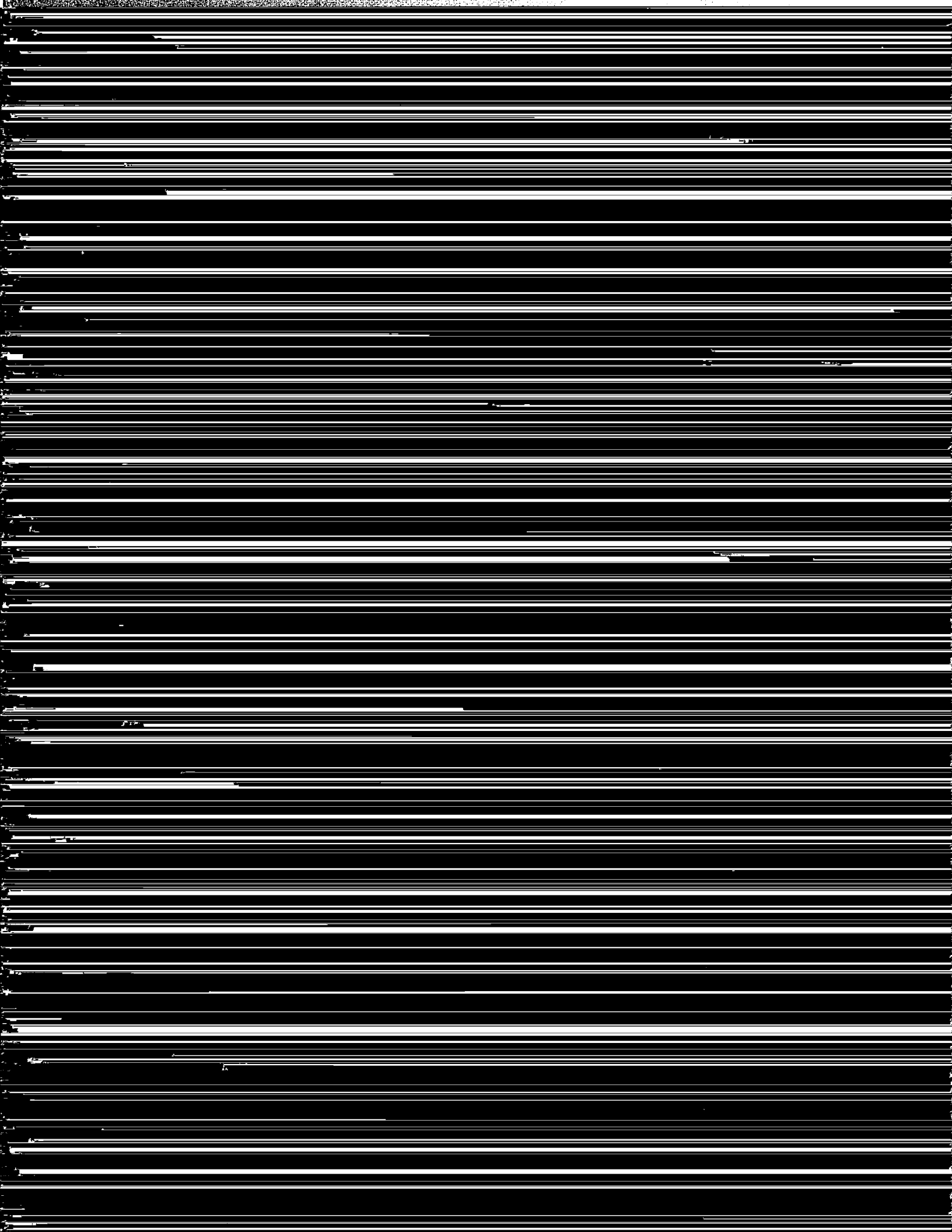
